Christmas Open Studio to Cheer and Inspire London

NEW CROSS, LONDON - 31 October 2018

Award-winning local artist Jan Bowman has announced her first Open House in Deptford. Visitors will be able to buy her elegant, optimistic prints of London and other cities, including a new series of images of Venice, Italy, and discover how she found nds inspiration and creates her work.

From Scotland via Canada, Jan is an architect-trained illustrator and author whose lyrical, cheerful pictures of people and places capture unexpected angles and overlooked corners. Her first book THIS IS BIRMINGHAM: A Glimpse of the City's Secret Treasures (a history of the 18th-century Lunar Society) spent nine months on Waterstone's Recommended list and gives such a positive account of the City's history that it is now used as an award in Birmingham schools. Now Jan aims to do the same for Deptford and its history.

Jan said "It's too often assumed that to be a socially aware artist you should emulate 1930s artists such as Otto Dix or George Grosz, and draw attention to how awful people can be; but today's zeitgeist is very different from then. Society has lost faith in itself. Humanity is underrated everywhere. The world is full of tragedy and horror, but it's also full of beauty; and I think the artist's job should be to counsel against despair. My pictures aim to show the best aspects of 21st-century civilisation – and Deptford is full of hidden gems."

Jan is now working on a visual history of Deptford and John Evelyn, and seeking a publisher for her second book, ARTHUR: the graphic memoir of a resourceful scout leader and bicycle mechanic who grew up in the shadow of World War II.

Jan's Open Studio is the first weekend in December, at 241 Glenville Grove, New Cross SE4 8BT - two minutes from Deptford's bustling market and High Street, and two minutes from New Cross Station (which is just one stop from London Bridge). Open from 12-6pm on Saturday and Sunday 1-2 December. The Private View is 6pm-9pm, Thursday 29 November. Jan is available for interviews.

Jan trained at the Mackintosh School of Architecture in Glasgow and has been a professional artist for 15 years.
